About this survey


- The AmericasBarometer is a biennial comparative survey of democratic values and behaviours that covers countries in North, Central and South America, as well as a significant number of countries in the Caribbean (the 2023 survey covers 25 countries).
- The project is led by the Latin American Public Opinion Project (LAPOP) at Vanderbilt University.
- The 2023 AmericasBarometer in Canada survey was conducted by the Environics Institute for Survey Research, in partnership with LAPOP at Vanderbilt University. It was conducted online with a representative sample of 2,500 Canadians (aged 18 and over) between July 20 and August 4, 2023




Support for the political system of Canada




Pride in living under the political system of Canada




To what extent do you trust the Supreme Court?


