About this survey

- The AmericasBarometer is a biennial comparative survey of democratic values and behaviours that covers countries in North, Central and South America, as well as a significant number of countries in the Caribbean (the 2023 survey covers 25 countries).
- The project is led by the <u>Latin American Public Opinion Project (LAPOP)</u> at Vanderbilt University.
- The 2023 AmericasBarometer in Canada survey was conducted by the Environics Institute for Survey Research, in partnership with LAPOP at Vanderbilt University. It was conducted online with a representative sample of 2,500 Canadians (aged 18 and over) between July 20 and August 4, 2023






A lot of support for the political system




Positive support for the political system



Some or a lot of support for the political system




To what extent do you respect the political institutions of Canada?

To what extent do you think that one should support the political system of Canada?



To what extent do you feel proud of living under the political system of Canada?














To what extent do you trust Parliament?


To what extent do you trust the Prime Minister?

To what extent do you trust your municipal government?




To what extent do you trust the mass media?






A lot of trust in the justice system

Positive trust in the justice system


% answering above the midpoint (5 to 7) on the 7-point scale



To what extent do you think the courts in Canada guarantee a fair trial?






