


# **2018 Survey of Jews in Canada**









## **Study objectives**



- First-ever national survey of Canadian Jews, with a large representative sample to capture the diversity of this population
- Incorporate measures from the Survey of American Jews, as a basis of comparison
- Establish benchmark data and insight to guide Jewish community organizations, academic research, and broader public knowledge
- Provide a more complete portrait of what it means to be a Jew in Canada today

## **Survey themes**



- Jewish identity
- Jewish practice (self and family)
- Childhood upbringing
- Experiences with discrimination and anti-Semitism
- Connection to Israel
- Connections to local Jewish community

## Sampling strategy



- Focus on four cities with largest Jewish population (84% of national total)
- Age and gender quotas for each city
- Multi-stage sampling plan
- Survey conducted by telephone and online
- Eligibility based on self-identification as Jewish or part- Jewish
- Extended field period (February September 2018)



#### (%) By Jewish identity








